In today gospel of Mark, Jesus is sending his apostles to preach the kingdom of God. They have received some training for doing this mission, but they have to trust in God's providence and the strength of the Holy Spirit in order to be successful. And they did succeed!

Almost two thousand years later, Jesus is still sending people to preach the gospel and to proclaim the kingdom of God. Few people decide to do it full time by consecrating their lives for the service of God's people as priests, missionaries, or religious brothers and sisters; most people proclaim the Good News as husbands, wives, children, grandchildren, grandparents, brothers and sisters, coworkers, neighbors and friends. Perhaps not many of us have "authority over unclean spirits" or are able to heal the sick, but certainly all are called to proclaim the Gospel.

One of the situations that we are facing now is that we do not have the same number of people consecrating their lives for the sake of the Gospel. Fifty years ago, the Archdiocese of Chicago was ordaining about 40 men every year to serve as priests in our parishes. Nowadays, we are ordaining about 10 every year. But the number of priests we are losing every year because of retirement, death, or leaving ministry for different reasons is about 30. So, every year we are losing about 20 priests in Chicago. In the next five years, we will lose 100 or more priests. That is one of the reasons Cardinal Blase Cupich started Renew My Church. We have too many parishes and too few priests. I believe God will provide for His Church, but He will not send them down from heaven. We are God's hands that need to work to send laborers to His harvest.

When was the last time you invited a young person to consider being a priest? –Your son, grandson, brother, nephew, neighbor– God is still sowing seeds for vocations to the priesthood, but the seeds need nourishment, care, and support. We are the ones who are to give that care. If you do not do it, nobody will. All of us who are priests have had, in our vocational journey, someone who inspired us, invited us, encouraged us and even sometimes pushed us to respond 'yes' to the Lord. God is expecting that each of us will do our part. If we do not do it, we cannot blame anyone else.

We are assigning a new coordinator in order to continue with a good program for the excellent faith formation of our children and their preparation to celebrate the sacraments of initiation. En el evangelio de Marcos de hoy, Jesús envía a sus apóstoles a predicar el reino de Dios. Ellos han recibido un entrenamiento para realizar este ministerio, pero tienen que confiar en la providencia de Dios y la fortaleza del Espíritu Santo para poder tener éxito. ¡Y así lo hacen!

Casi dos mil años después, Jesús sigue enviando gente a predicar el evangelio y proclamar el reino de Dios. Pocas personas deciden hacerlo de tiempo completo consagrando

sus vidas para el servicio del pueblo de Dios como sacerdotes, misioneros, o hermanos y hermanas religiosos; la mayoría lo hacen desde su propia realidad como esposos, esposas, hijos, nietos, abuelos, hermanos y hermanas, compañeros de trabajos, vecinos y amigos. Posiblemente no tengamos "poder sobre los espíritus inmundos" o podamos curar a los enfermos, pero ciertamente estamos llamados a proclamar el Evangelio.

Una de las situaciones que enfrentamos en estos días es que no tenemos el mismo número de personas que consagran sus vidas por el Evangelio. Hace 50 años, la arquidiócesis de Chicago ordenaba en promedio 40 sacerdotes al año para servir en nuestras parroquias. Ahora ordenan unos 10 cada año. Pero el número de sacerdotes que perdemos en Chicago cada año por que se jubilan, mueren, o dejar en ministerio por diferentes razones, es de 20. En los próximos 5 años tendremos 100 sacerdotes menos. Ésta es una de las razones por la que el cardenal Blase Cupich comenzó Renueva Mi Iglesia. Tenemos muchas parroquias y muy pocos sacerdotes. Yo creo que Dios proveerá para su Iglesia, pero no los va a mandar del cielo. Nosotros somos sus manos y necesitamos trabajar para enviar trabajadores a sus campos.

¿Cuándo fue la última vez que invitaron a un joven a considerar ser sacerdote? –Su hijo, nieto, hermano, sobrino, vecino, amigo– Dios todavía siembra semilla para las vocaciones sacerdotales, pero esas semillas necesitan de nutrición, cuidado, apoyo. Nosotros somos quienes les debemos cuidar. Si no lo hacemos, nadie más lo hará. Todos los sacerdotes hemos tenido, en nuestro camino, alguien que nos inspiró, nos invitó, nos animó, e inclusive nos empujó para responder 'sí' al Señor. Dios espera que cada uno hagamos nuestra parte. Si no lo hacemos, no le podemos echar la culpa a alguien más.

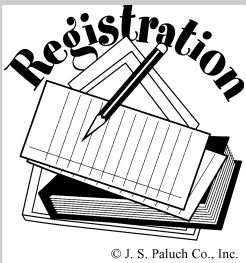
CONSEJO PASTORAL PARROQUIAL

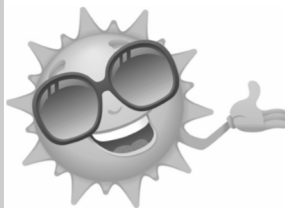

BAPTISM: Come at least two (2) months in advance, talk with one of the priest on Tuesdays from 4pm to 7 pm, or any other day by appointment. You need to be a registered active parishioner of any parish to be eligible for baptizing your child with us. We celebrate baptism the first and third Saturdays of the month in Spanish, and the second and fourth Saturdays of the month in English. We do not celebrate baptisms during the Lenten season.

QUINCEAÑERA: The youth needs to have the sacraments of initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, and First Communion), and to be a registered active member of our parish to have her celebration with us. Parents have to come, at least four (4) months in advance, to talk with one of the priests on Tuesdays from 4pm to 7pm, or any other day by appointment.

SACRAMENTALS: For any other sacramental celebrations like Presentations of children, blessing of homes, cars or anything else, come to the office to meet with a priest on Tuesdays from 4pm to 7pm, call to (773) 523-3917 or by e-mail: blessedsacrament@bspchicago.org

BAUTISMOS: Venga a la oficina para hablar con uno de los sacerdotes al menos dos (2) meses antes de la fecha deseada para el bautismo, los martes de 4 a 7 de la tarde, o haciendo cita. Necesita ser feligrés registrado y activo de alguna parroquia para poder bautizar en nuestra parroquia. Celebramos el bautismo el primer y tercer sábado del mes, en español, y el segundo y cuarto sábado en inglés. No celebramos bautizos durante el tiempo de cuaresma.

QUINCEAÑERA: La joven quinceañera tiene que tener todos los sacramentos de iniciación (Bautismo, Confirmación y Primera Comunión), y ser miembro registrado y activa de nuestra parroquia. Los padres tienen que venir, al menos con cuatro (4) meses de anticipación, para hablar con uno de los sacerdotes, los martes, de 4 a 7 de la tarde o cualquier otro día con previa cita.
